FARM TOURS**

Welcome to 41° South Salmon and Ginseng Farm and thank you for choosing to take a self guided tour.

Our farm has been set up to grow Atlantic Salmon and, to use a natural and man-made wetland as a bio filter to filter all the fish waste. The salmon are housed in 20 concrete tanks and we make sure there is a low stock density in each tank, so that the fish have enough space to swim around. The water that leaves the farm, leaves it twice as clean as when it comes in, feeding the native flora and creating a habitat for the local fauna.

In the feeding ponds you can see Atlantic Salmon, Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout, Albino Rainbow Trout and you might even spot an Eel or two. These fish in the ponds range anywhere from 1- 5 years old and can weigh between 1- 10kg.

Along the walk you can view the lower half of the Montana Falls cascades and wander around the wetlands where you will see a wide variety of native and introduced trees, flowers and shrubs. Also keep an eye out for the local wildlife, you might be lucky and spot a Platypus, Echidna, Wallaby, Wombat, Wedge Tail Eagle or any of the other 30 bird species we have spotted on the farm. You never know what the rustling in the bushes could be.

We hope you enjoy your walk around the farm. If you have any other questions please feel free to ask one of the staff in the shop on your way back.

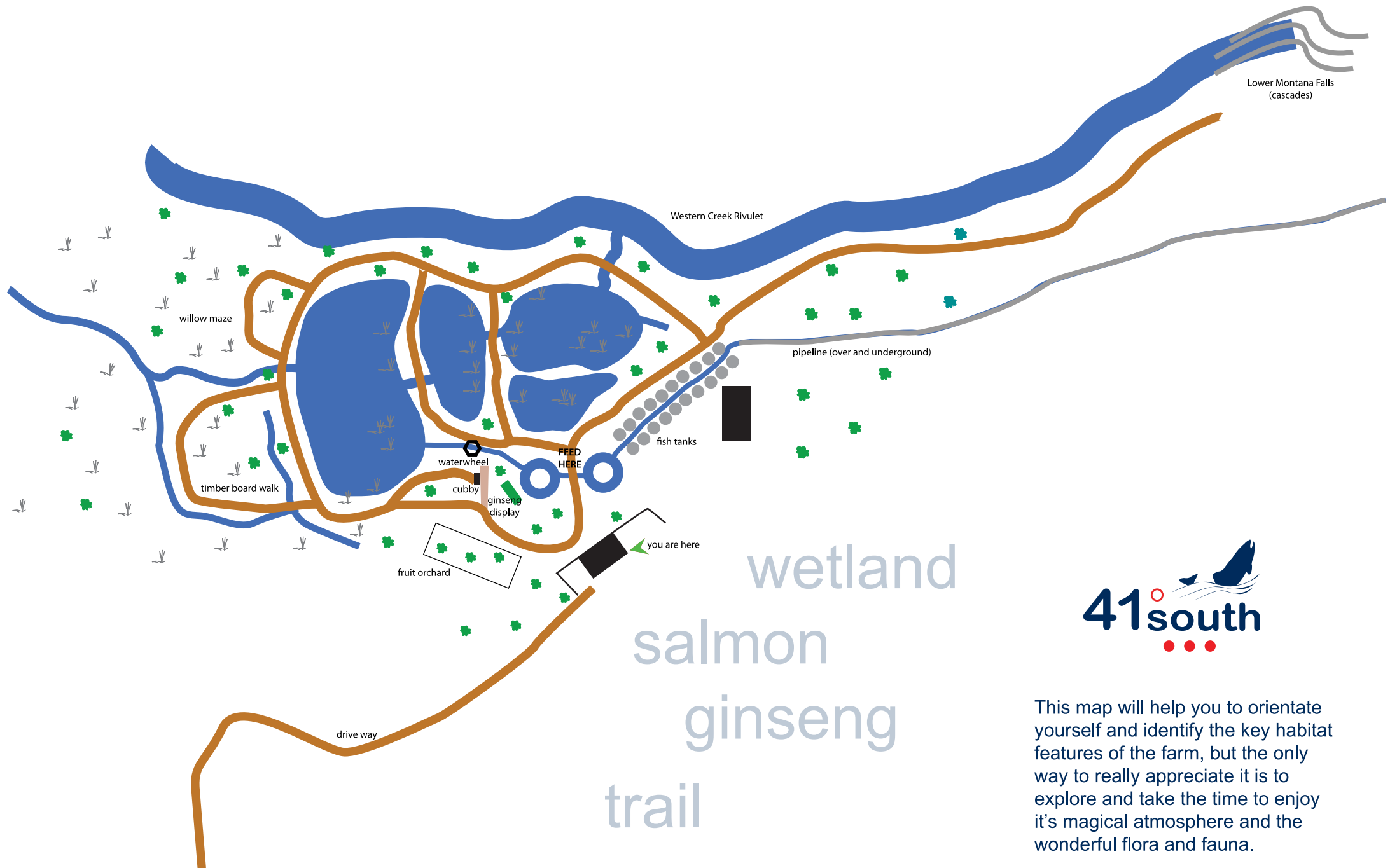
